The Government of India has announced Jeevan Raksha Padak Series of awards, 2015. Jeevan Rakshak Padak Series of awards are given for courageous acts of human nature in saving the life of a person in incidents like drowning, accidents, fire incidents, electrocution, landslides, animal attacks and rescue operation in mines etc. The award is given to a rescuer for conspicuous courage under circumstances of very great danger to the life of the rescuer. It is given in the following three categories:

- (i) Sarvottam Jeevan Raksha Padak
- (ii) Uttam Jeevan Raksha Padak
- (iii) Jeevan Raksha Padak

A copy of the letter dated 4th March, 2015 from Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India giving details of the awards including eligibility, procedure and proforma for recommendation etc. is available on the UGC website under 'Notices'.

The recommendations for the awards are considered by Awards Committee within a period of two years from the date of performance of the act. Therefore, for the year 2015, any recommendation in respect of which the date of performance of the act falls prior to 1st October, 2013 should not be forwarded.

You are requested to bring it to the notice of all concerned and send the recommendations of suitable candidates for the Jeevan Raksha Padak Awards directly to the Director, Ministry of Home, Government of India, North Block, New Delhi-110 001 latest by 30th September, 2015.
