Guidelines for 'Teaching Innovator-2016' Award under PMMMNMTT

PURPOSE

Recognition for teaching innovation — *Teaching Innovator- 2016* - under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) aims to identify, recognize and reward teaching innovations practiced in our higher education institutions such as colleges and universities. Teaching innovations could be in the areas of teaching methods, student assessment, curriculum design, technology adoption in teaching, or other aspects of teaching in higher education. The Award recognizes the teacher initiatives only, and not that of the institution.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. College or university teachers working in institutions of following categories are eligible for the award:
 - a. State and Central Universities, institutions of national eminence such as IITs, IIMs, IISc, IISER, NITTR, and other Government and Government aided colleges;
 - Universities which deal with unitary discipline like medicine, law, engineering, agriculture, etc., are excluded from the Scheme;
 - c. Teachers employed in private universities and colleges are not eligible to participate.
- Teachers at various levels on the payrolls of the above mentioned institutions are eligible for nomination to the Award. This would include temporary and contract teachers employed by these institutions.

RECOGNITION

Teaching Innovator-2016 will recognize up to 20 teaching innovations. The winners will receive a citation and cash award. In addition, the Scheme will also recognize an appropriate number of teaching innovations for commendation as decided by the Selection Committee.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The award will adopt the following selection procedure:

- Teaching Innovator-2016 follows multistage selection criteria. Incremental information about the nominees
 and the teaching innovation will be elicited from the selected nominees at different stages.
- Eligible candidates may self-nominate or be nominated by the institution/ colleagues / students at Stage I of the nomination.
- Award Selection Committee consisting of three expert academics, assisted by the select project staff will
 shortlist nominated teaching innovations based on criteria such as novelty, relevance, scalability, social
 impact, sustainability, and other relevant aspects at Stage I.
- 4. The shortlisted nominees are expected to provide more details about the teaching innovation, institutional endorsement and other support information at Stage II.
- 5. At Stage II, Award Selection Committee will scrutinize the nominations and shortlist the candidates based on a set of criteria the Committee evolves, including giving weightages to Teaching innovation, Teaching philosophy statement by the nominee, Institutional endorsement, Peer group and student (alumni) support, and other relevant contributions of the nominee.
- At Stage III, nominees shortlisted at Stage II are invited to make presentation of their innovation before a Panel of Experts.
- The Award winners are selected by the Panel of Experts for recognition from those who are invited for presentation.

 information.

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
