We will be happy to host your debating team.



### **Rules of Taradevi intercollegiate debate:**

1. The team from one institute will comprise of 2 participants (UG students), one speaking for the motion and the other against it.
2. Language of presentation can be English, Hindi or Marathi
3. Participants should report at 10.15.AM on 10<sup>th</sup> Sept 16 to the organizing team in Anatomy lecture hall, MGIMS. They must have their Institutional Identity Cards with them.
4. There will be 2 consecutive rounds. Round 'A' is compulsory while round 'B' is optional. The marks of round 'B' will not be included in the team performance rating; however the best interjection / clarification will receive an award.
  - A. Presentation round -time given to each participant will be 5 minutes. Warning bell will be given at 4 min.
  - B. Interjection round – each participant can interject another participant of any other institute who has spoken opposite to his/her motion of presentation during round 'A'. The interjected participant has to defend the interjection made, by giving a clarification. Each participant can speak twice in this round - once to defend and again to interject. Time given to each participant is 1 minute. Each participant can be interjected only once.
5. TA/DA for participation will have to be borne by the candidate / sponsoring Institute.
