Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNM TT)

The PMMMNM TT is a central scheme launched by the MHRD, Govt. of India with all- India coverage. One of the important goals of the mission is to empower teachers and faculty members of higher education institutions through training, re-training, induction, orientation and refresher programmes in generic skills, pedagogic skills, and discipline specific content upgradation, ICT and technology enabled training and other appropriate interventions.

Five Day National Workshop on Developing e-content/ MOOCs for Teacher Education

The last decade has witnessed a growing emphasis on integration of Open Educational Resources (OER) and online courses in higher education particularly teacher education programme. However, a majority of teachers do not feel prepared for online teaching and learning as they do not have adequate awareness of- how to access and utilize the online resources and also how to develop and deliver e-content/online resources. In most of the cases, integration of technology is limited to use of power point presentation in the class rooms and web resources for completion of assignment and projects and sending learning materials through e-mails, WhatsApp and other media.

MHRD, Govt. of India has launched massive open online courses (MOOCs) through Swayam platform in various disciplines to bring learning close to people and thus add to qualitative and quantitative expansion of education including teacher education. It enables good teachers to reach the unreached and directly teach them. It offers an interactive learning experience through flexible audio-video and multimedia e-content for both the students and the teachers. Moreover, the digital modes are cheaper, accessible and interactive. In addition, SWAYAM PRABHA conceived as group of 32 DTH channels devoted to telecasting of high-quality educational programmes on 24X7 basis has also been launched using the GSAT-15 satellite.

This workshop aims to provide an experience sharing platform to the participants where they can have hands-on experience developing e-content in the discipline of teacher education and education in general, besides developing conceptual understanding of OER and skills of developing e-content.

Objectives

The present workshop will facilitate the participants-

- to develop conceptual understanding of OER resources in teacher education and creative common license.
- to acquire basic knowledge and skills to develop e-content in teacher education with the help of e-content development tools.

- to develop and share e-content with the help of web 2.0 based applications and mobile applications in teacher education
- to develop-content collaboratively with the Google tools
- to develop and deliver e-content and online courses in teacher education through LMS.
- to conceptualize the basic structural and functional details of Swayam, MOOCs and Swayam Prabha channels related to teacher education.
- to utilize MOOCs courses and other open educational resources for their day to day F2F teaching in teacher education.

Tasks to be undertaken in the Workshop?

- Exercising the basic skills of working with OERs in teacher education
- Creating graphic, audio, video and animation as well as multimedia e-content with the help of e-content development tools in teacher education
- Creating, publishing and sharing e-content with blogs, wiki and mobile applications
- Creating, publishing and sharing e-content with collaborative Google tools
- Exercising the development and delivery of e-content/online courses in teacher education through LMS
- Reflecting upon the basic structure and functioning of Swayam MOOCs and Swayam Prabha channels related to teacher education
- Developing e-content using 4-quadrant approach on any topic of interest for any of the courses of teacher education.
